WHO has declared the COVID-19 epidemic affecting countries as a Pandemic. Due to the inflow of persons from affected countries, other state has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease and has gone forward in identifying almost all possible contacts thereby preventing the spread of disease and timely health interventions to affected persons. State-level, District level, and Local Self Government Institution level structures have been set up in the state to ensure a coordinated response to COVID 19 management. Interdepartmental coordination at the district level to handle issues and

spreading of information, education, and communication-related to COVID 19 is spearheaded by the District Administration.

Covid19 Care Center is a comprehensive solution for effective daily reporting/monitoring of the quarantine and health status of the people under surveillance by Field Health Workers and provision of health service through the Medical Officers based on the reports available in the hospital. Our college Covid Care center starts from 21st July 2020 & it is ended at 25-08-2020. Nearly 730 patients benefitted from this care center.

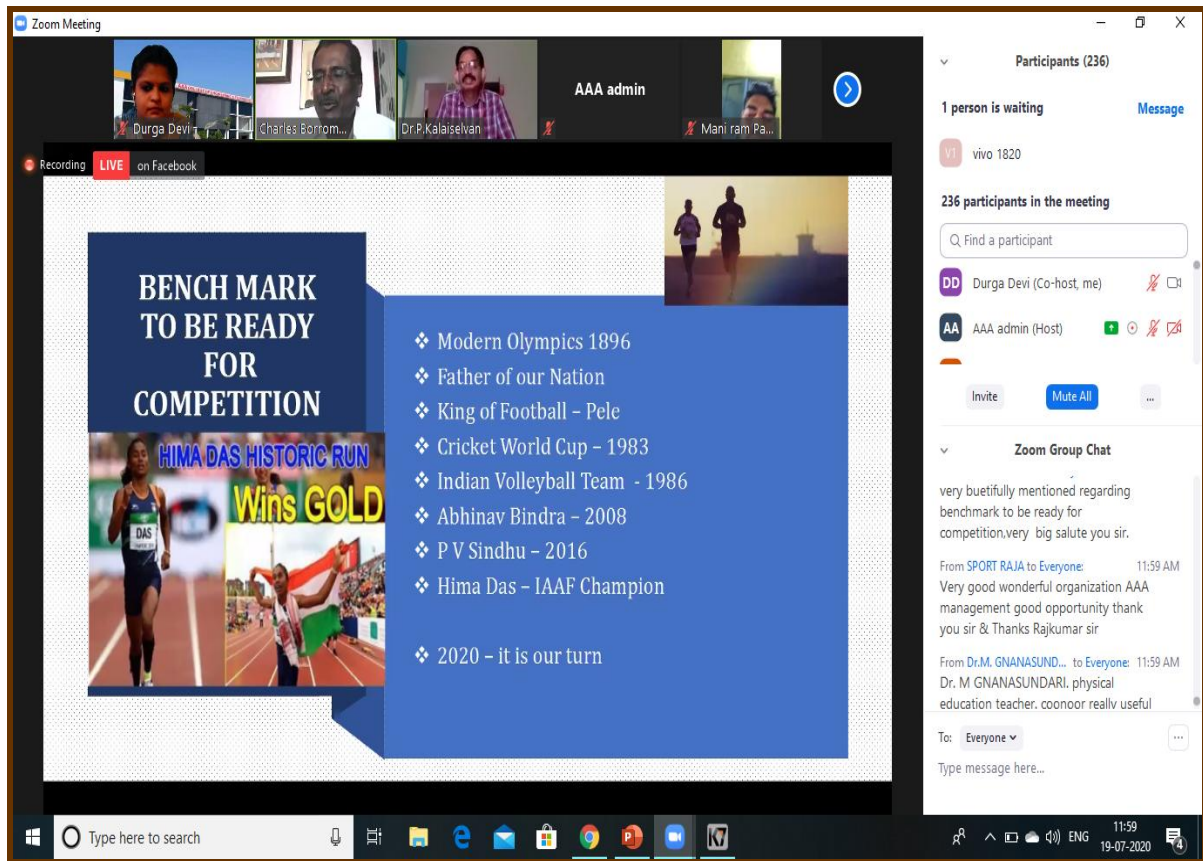
